CLARK SET TO GO #1

Caitlin Clark to be obvious top choice for Indiana Fever with No. 1 pick

The 2024 WNBA Draft class is taking shape. Headlining draft decisions was the declaration of Iowa Hawkeyes superstar Caitlin Clark, who announced her intentions to enter the WNBA on Feb. 29.

Clark became the all-time leading scorer in college basketball this season, is viewed by most as the top prospect in a draft class full of star power. The Indiana



Fever finished the 2023 season with a 13-27 record and won the 2024 draft lottery, giving them the first overall selection. While Indiana has held on to the top pick, several offseason trades have impacted the remainder of the first-round draft order.
